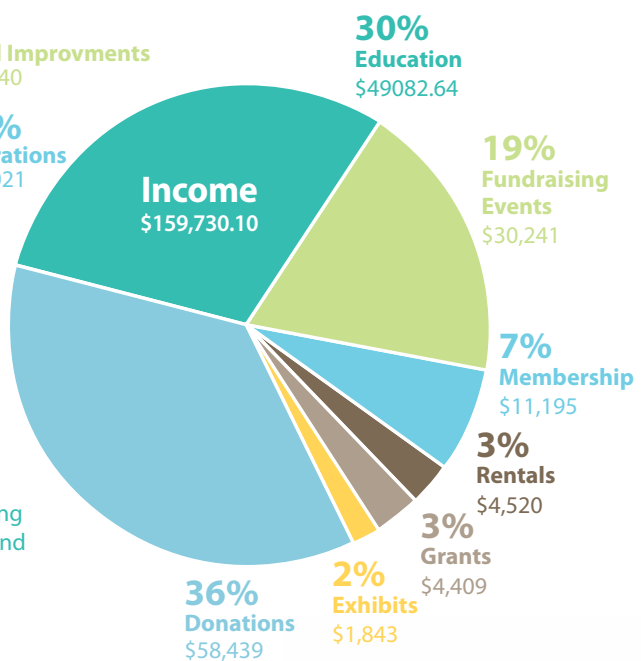

Bridges over Preble County

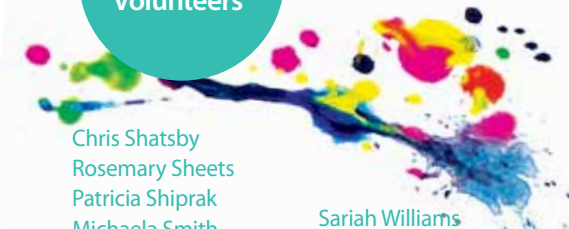
